



Applied Dual-Use Biosecurity Education: Bursaries Available

Under the BioEngagement Program the US Department of State are offering 15 bursaries for participation in the following course offered by the University of Bradford:

An online Train-the-Trainer Module in Applied Dual-Use Biosecurity Education

The module is 12 weeks in length and will be starting the week of the 26th September 2011. The class will meet for about 2.5 hours per week. Upon completion of the module participants will be awarded 20 UK Higher Education Master's level credits and a Certificate of Continuing Education. All classes and discussions take place online.

Individuals from the following countries are encouraged to apply: **Afghanistan, Algeria, Bahrain, Egypt, India, Indonesia, Iraq, Jordan, Kenya, Kuwait, Malaysia, Mali, Mauritania, Morocco, Nigeria, Oman, Pakistan, Philippines, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, UAE, Uganda, or Yemen.**

Past Participants have included professionals from Research Institutes, Academia, Biosafety Officers and Policy Makers.
